



1. AEDs

Following the introduction of AED mapping there is now a requirement for dental practices to provide emergency care outwith their premises as first responders. In light of this additional responsibility this conference proposes that GPs and their staff will no longer be required to self-finance their annual BLS training and should be reimbursed for any such costs which are incurred

4. General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

6. CPI Allowance

This conference proposes a meaningful CPI allowance payable as part of any future Protected Learning Time (PLT) proposal where issues have been identified during a CPI and successfully addressed as part of a QI project

7. LDC Mandates

Due to the increasing difficulty LDCs are experiencing in attracting members' mandates and the resultant concern with financial stability, we call upon the SDPC to initiate discussion with all interested parties

8. SDR Restorative Case Referrals

This conference seeks additional service provision for advanced restorative cases (Tier 2) under the NHS where the SDR is inadequate and secondary care can no longer cope with the volume of referrals with complex treatment needs

This conference demands that Lothian Health Board provides a properly funded NHS Lothian Oral Health Service so that GDP's are able to refer their patients for specialist restorative treatment where they feel that the treatment required by the patient is out with their competency

10. OHRA

14. SCI Gateway

This conference proposes that the dental SCI Gateway referral system should be reviewed and redesigned to an agreed national standard. Furthermore, dental SCI Gateway should be uniformly adopted across all Health Boards to enable two-way communication and facilitate efficient electronic patient referrals that are fit for purpose

15a. Minamata Convention on Amalgam

This conference proposes the removal of a stabilisation fee for pregnant and breastfeeding mothers. This should be a fee for definitive treatment and should not be on prior approval since the MatB1 certificate confirms their status

15b. Minamata Convention on Amalgam

If Scottish Government is serious about implementing Minamata then they should allow definitive non-amalgam restorations to be placed not just in children but in pregnant or breastfeeding mothers

18. Dental Practice Management Systems

This conference proposes that Scottish Government would provide general dental practitioners with access to a supported single practice management computer system. This system would be comparable to the general medical practice management system. It is posited that hardware and software updates would be included in this system. It would integrate with relevant systems such as PSD, e-prior approval, OHRA and SCI Gateway so as to avoid duplicating information and increasing GDP work-load. This robust e-Dental programme should be procured, maintained, integrated and updated by Scottish Government

19. Prescribed Medicines Dental Database
